

Your Support Could Make All The Difference

▶ HOW IT WORKS

- We work with you to determine which route would best fit your team.
- Your organization appoints a team leader who will coordinate your team members.
- Your organization sends a volunteer, or two, to deliver meals to your assigned route 1 day a week (or 1 day a month) for a year.

▶ VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 21 or older with an acceptable driving history.
- Must have your own vehicle, valid driver's license, and auto insurance.
- Must pass a background check.
- Must be able to cover your agreed upon route every week/month.

Remember: Seniors count on us, we need to be able to count on you

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Deliveries can take 3-4 hours, sometimes less, depending on route.
- Routes are between 9:00am and 2:00pm Monday through Friday.
- Our routes are in Jefferson, Geneva, Conneaut, and Ashtabula.
- We will train you!
- Paid positions, substitute positions, and individual volunteer opportunities are also available.



The levy provides services to Seniors aged 60 and over in all areas of the County. Services consist of:

- **Homemaker** - Provides supportive daily living services to seniors, so they can continue to live independently in a safe, clean, and healthy environment.
- **Home Delivered Meals** - Consists of services or activities designed to prepare and deliver one or more meals a day to an individual's residence to prevent institutionalization, malnutrition, and isolation.
- **Personal Care** - Provides basic health maintenance and/or personal hygiene assistance to individuals in their homes.
- **Transportation** - Provides for both Medical and Non-Medical transportation of Ashtabula County residents age 60 and over.
- **Chore/Handyman** - Designed to improve, restore, or maintain a clean, sanitary, and safe living environment through the performance of minor tasks in and around the home that are beyond the senior's capability; and the removal of hazards that may pose a threat to a senior's health and welfare.
- **Independence & Wellness** - Offers opportunities for socialization, wellness education and promotion, recreational and physical activities, linkage to life-enhancing community services and healthy aging.
- **Adult Protective Services, including Guardianship and Payeeship** - Assists seniors, age 60 and over who are functionally impaired, unable to meet their own needs, or may be victims of abuse, neglect or exploitation.

Safety Town will be back this summer for in-coming Kindergarten students. Registration forms will be available at kindergarten registration for Lakeside Elementary, Saint John School and Ridgeview Elementary. The deadline to register your child is 6/9/25.

Safety Town is a free program to kids going into kindergarten in the fall of 2025. There are four sessions available between June 23rd through July 4th. Each child may be enrolled into one of the four sessions. Each session is 1 week in duration for 2 1/4 hrs. per day.

Safety Town is a fun activities-based safety education program which covers many topics such as:
